**Subject:** FUN FAIR - 16th July - 19th July

Once again a *minority* of Great Cambourne residents would like to remind the Parish Council of agreements made after the first visit of this Fun Fair and the continuing failure of these agreements being implemented thereby the Parish Council failing once again to respect residents' concerns during this FUN FAIR's previous visits. Hopefully this year things will be better if attention could be given to the following.

I hope that you will take notice and assure us that the following points are raised with the contractors and that Parish Councillors attend the Fair during its stay on Great Cambourne Green to ensure that appropriate respect is given to those whose homes adjoin Great Cambourne Green.

The Fair arrives on Sunday and during daylight hours we are subjected to noise of construction of the 'rides' and the running of heavy engines and the accompanying exhaust pollution. This activity lasts for days till Fair Opens. We hope that this kept to a minimum.

That the contractors Larry Gray keep to the agreed times of opening and running of the Fair and that all generators and associated equipment are silenced by 10 pm, In 2013 one evening the fair did not close at the advertised time and overran by 30 minutes.

That on the evening closure on Saturday 19th July that there is no overnight site working and running of generators as occurred in 2012/2013.

That there a complete ban on the consumption of alcohol within the Fair and such notices being displayed prominently.

That Parish Councillors attend on a regular basis during the running of the Fair to ensure that respect is being maintained not only for visitors but also those who live in the area and especially that closure times are maintained without fail.

That this event and that of the Circus is discussed in detail at the next L and A meeting in September where a TOTAL review of this year's Fair and Circus can be fully discussed.

I shall look forward to your assurance that the above points are addressed by the Parish Council before 13th July 2014
