Police Report

September 2014

I have made a review of the reported incidents for the period between the 2nd September and 2nd October, there were 158 incidents reported for the area with 131 in Cambourne last year compared to 174 with 139 in Cambourne for the same period this year.

There were 17 different types of incident called in, the most frequent calls for Cambourne were as follows:-

15 Concern reports – examples of these calls related to a person screaming in the street, Alarm sounding at Morrisons, flour being thrown from a vehicle, and plant pots being moved in a sheltered home

10 Suspicious circumstances - examples of these calls related to receipt of strange text messages, a concern for a resident, a drunk in the street, and children being left at home alone

8 reports of missing person, a number of these related to one person who is not getting on at home

8 reports of road traffic collisions, some of these happened within Morrisons car park

7 reports of rowdy / nuisance behaviour

5 reports of excess noise

5 reports of missing property – mainly wheelie bins

In relation to crime there were 34 crimes reported for the area with 26 in Cambourne last year, compared with 34 reports for the area with 30 in Cambourne this year:

Most frequent offences recorded were:-

4 possession of controlled drug

4 criminal damage

4 theft - elsewhere

Six of the above have been detected and twenty one are still being investigated.
