Cambourne Parish Council Police Report June 2015 Period 2nd June to 1st July

I have slightly changed the reporting period to give a better reflection of reports to the Police, in this period there have been 158 Incidents for the area with 128 in Cambourne. For the same period last year there were a total of 195 incidents reported with 128 in Cambourne, the most frequent calls received were:-

14 x Domestic disputes

13 x Rowdy nuisances

7 x Concerns for welfare – Unwanted visitors, Lost person, Motorcycles on bridlepath, Child locked in car, Child playing with phone.

3 x Road Traffic collision – of note the bus at Broad Street

There have been 41 crimes reported for the area with 35 being in Cambourne, compared to 29 crimes for the same period last year, with 21 in Cambourne.

The most frequent being: -

14 X Criminal Damages which includes the slogan on the Soul centre

7 x Theft

3 x Common assaults

1 x Burglary dwelling

At the time of writing one of the above two have been detected, and the others are not detected but still under investigation

I have started operating a Police contact point in Morrison's supermarket and have scheduled the following dates as follow up as per the attached poster
