TESCO CLICK AND COLLECT SERVICE.

The Parish Council has received a request from Shane Railley on behalf of Everyone Active, to locate a Tesco Click and Collect on the site of the sport centre.

SLM are working with Tesco's to provide a collection point at locations remote from the stores to allow residents to meet a delivery van at a central location to reduce vehicle movements and improve the service provided.

Cambourne has been identified as one of the initial sites for this new provision. This is an annually renewed agreement which can be terminated if it has a detrimental effect on the centre.

It will be written into the agreement that the service will be suspended on Saturdays and Sundays when peak demand for parking space is required.

Recommended that the Council consider agreeing to the siting of the Click and Collect point in the rear car park for a year's trial period.




