Dear Parish Council / L&A Committee,

As a resident of Upper Cambourne, I was wondering if you had plans to or would consider providing one or two more benches for the green?

Currently there are 2 benches on the small gravel path running between Brace Dein to Sterling Way. The benches are very close to the play area, the school and the busy junction of Sterling Way/ Brace Dein/ Beaufort Way and as such are not really conducive to "quiet time".

I thought that it might be nice to have one or two benches at the other end of the green. There are several trees lining Mosquito Road and it might be nice for the benches to be facing the afternoon sun and near the trees with their backs to Mosquito Road and the "wildlife hillocks".

I hope the above makes sense. I don't know what would constitute an acceptable site, but I would be happy to show you the suggested location and/or discuss this further with you.
