TRAFFIC MATTERS AND ROAD SAFETY.

Cambourne transport.

Correspondence was received from Councillor Bhattacharya highlighting the lack of public transport provision in Upper Cambourne and as a none driving member of the community, it has presented challenges in getting to and from various locations in a timely manner.

Cllr Bhattacharya has expressed the concern for the amount it costs for a taxi within Cambourne and the impracticalities of using this form of transport on a regular basis.

There have been three systems found that could be available to non - driving residents in Cambourne and these are:

1. Community Car system in Cambourne.

2. Few villages operate a **Community minibus** locally and they are keen to promote

its use. The minibus is available for group and private hire journeys. The minibus is

fully wheelchair accessible.

3. Taxicard Scheme is there for Cambourne (Great, Lower & Upper).

West Cambourne will be starting in the very near future and the transport challenges will grow. Could the Council help with suggestions on how to help the community with working with these schemes or looking at other alternatives.
