IMPORTANT NOTE: I have received an update from DA Cant regarding their date for the weekend working on the junction of Lancaster Gate and Sterling Way. This will no longer be on the Bank Holiday weekend, but the weekend following that. Thus, the full package of bus and weekend working info should now read:

Attached is a drawing showing the current bus diversion for the No.4 bus. The key shows the original route in green, the closed route in red (Sterling Way), and the diverted route in gold (Mosquito Road and Brace Dein), with black directional arrows. There are temporary stops in place on the loop of Mosquito Road and Brace Dein. The diversion is currently expected to be in place until 2nd June.

There are two areas that are programmed for weekend working, because they can only be undertaken when there are no buses for the laying process, which will be the Sunday element of the operation. The second attached drawing shows these two locations, which are:

18th and 19th May – Junction of Mosquito Road and Sterling Way 1st and 2nd June – Junction of Lancaster Gate and Sterling Way
