Proposal to create a public bridleway in the parish of Cambourne

Cambridgeshire County Council is proposing to create a public bridleway around Upper Cambourne through a dedication agreement with the landowner under Section 25 of the Highways Act 1980.

If dedicated, the 2.05km bridleway will be recorded on the Definitive Map and Statement as shown of the attached plan between Points A-B-C-D. The routes would have a recorded width of six metres. The route has been constructed in accordance with the Cambourne Highway Design Guide.
