I walk my son to Jeavons Wood School every morning and the parking on Jeavons Lane where there is an access to the school via a footpath through the woods is becoming more and more serious. Today we were nearly run over as we weren't able to see the traffic in either direction due to the volume of cars parked on either side of the road.

Adding to the parking issues were several cars trying to get through the cars parked on either side and not being able to do so as well as the Stagecoach Citi4. This was followed by cars mounting the curb and damaging the grass verges,

When is something going to be done. Will something be done when a child gets run over?

We have no pedestrian crossings off any kind at Jeavons Wood School and at the very least I believe this section of the road should be double yellow lined to enable a better line of sight when crossing the road and for vehicle access.
