13.1 20 MPH SPEED LIMIT

The remaining two speed counts that had to be completed, where commenced on Saturday 5ht September 2020 and were completed on Friday 11th September 2020. Once the data has been received from TRACSIS, it will be forwarded to John O'Donnell at Cambridgeshire County Council to review what is required, to be able to implement a 20mph speed limit throughout Cambourne.

RECOMMENED that the report be received.

13.2 ZEBRA CROSSING

Lancaster Gate / Eastgate where adopted on 13th July 2020, enabling Cambridgeshire County Council to move forward with the Zebra Crossing. Lancaster Gate / Eastgate work is progressing. The zebra crossing has had a road safety audit conducted and the report is due shortly. The design has been amended since the original discussions, changing it to a parallel crossing (Zebra crossing with cycle crossing alongside). This would formalise cyclists crossing without dismounting. The crossing has been moved slightly further north, so that it is not in line with the existing cycle path route (as requested by the Development Management (CCC)) and it also avoids the iron work in the existing informal crossing location.

The Public Notice was circulated on 19th August 2020 for comments to be made by 11th September 2020.
