The Greater Cambridge Shared Planning Service, on behalf of Cambridge City Council and South Cambridgeshire District Council, has <u>published all the responses</u> submitted to the Greater Cambridge Local Plan 'First Conversation' consultation and Call for Sites, held earlier this year. South Cambs are not consulting on the sites at the moment as they are still working on the criteria that will be used to asses the sites, but it is worth looking at the impact and bear this in mind.

Some of the sites impinge on the Country parks that are due to be adopted by the Wildlife Trust and Cambourne Town Council. It would be worth reviewing the documents regarding this and the context of the proposed sites so this can be fed into the Local Plan team.
