3 What are the objectives of your organisation?
Cambridgeshire Search and Rescue (CamSAR) is the Lowland Rescue unit covering our county, often also assisting sister teams in the wider region. We are a specialist team, called upon by Police in the search for vulnerable missing people: a child, an elderly In the wider region. We are a specialist team, called upon by Police in the search for vulnerable missing people: a child, an elderly person suffering from dementia or even someone who is considering taking their own life. In each case an emergency response is vital. Working closely with our Lowland Rescue sister units and our partners at the UK Search and Rescue level, every team member is trained to exacting national standards and undergoes yearly re-certification. Our First Responders, Search Technicians, Team Leaders, Search Planners, Support Team, Operations Managers and Search Managers are available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year, the team is made up 100% of dedicated fully trained volunteers and receives no central government funding, relying entirely upon grants, fund raising and individual donations – and team members' own pockets – to continue to provide the service.

The purchase of three thermal imaging cameras to help find missing persons at night. We do not currently have this capability or technology in the team and doing so would greatly improve our success on night searches or in areas that are more challenging to search e.g.

We have identified the make and model of camera based on consultation with sister teams, notably Suffolk Search and Rescue, who have five such cameras. The specification is attached.
