Background

The South Cambs Community Safety Partnership (CSP), consisting of representatives from Fire & Rescue, Health, Police, South Cambs District Council, Cambridgeshire County Council and Probation Services is a statutory body, created to help make communities safer. It also seeks to ensure that the voices of local people are heard on policing and community safety issues. The CSP's 12 month action plan is endorsed by SCDC as the accountable body for the Partnership.

As part of our core duties, we commission an annual strategic assessment from the Cambridgeshire Research Group focusing on data from many sources, including police crime and Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB) statistics. This data is reviewed quarterly and from it is created a list of areas that should be prioritised for focussed work to address crime and ASB. Based on the current strategic assessment, Cambourne has been highlighted as an area for focus. On 25th November, we delivered this data to District Councillors from highlighted areas, to explain why these areas are flagging as priority areas. The CSP partners would then aim to carry out targeted, place-based events and awareness-raising programmes to address the issues and promote the resilience of the local community. Cllr Shrobona Bhattacharya attended the meeting on 25th November.

The next stage is to deliver this information to Town Councils and other relevant community leaders and Community groups. I would really like to get find a date that is suitable for everyone and meet before the end of January 2022.
