Town Clerks Report

Below is a short update on activities since the 1st March 2022. Some elements are covered by separate agenda items.

- A positive meeting was held with Duncan Mason of New-Crest, Ed Durrant, Associate Planner, Pegasus Group, Stephen Kelly Joint Director of Planning and Economic Development and Anne Ainsworth Chief Operating Officer South Cambs District Council regarding the development of the High Street. A second meeting has been arranged for Friday 1st April 2022 with the above people and the Architects and Planning Officers to move the project forward and hopefully enable a planning application to be made late summer 2022.
- Further discussions and meetings with Claire Coates Principal at Cambourne Village College regarding access to the College.
- Further discussions and progress meetings for the new Youth Building. The building is almost complete with the final bits being completed and the final clean being carried out on Friday 1st April 2022. The car park is complete and lined. I carried out two defect inspections which required a minimum amount of work to be carried out as we have been monitoring work as it has gone on to reduce issues to a minimum. We had a walkthrough of the electrical and mechanical systems (the Caretaker was in attendance). The hand over is scheduled to take place on the 4th April 2022. The leader of the District Council Bridget Smith had a tour of the building and was very impressed with what was being achieved. Councillors have been invited to look around the building on 6th April between 5 and 7pm. An open session will be held with the youth of Cambourne on Tuesday 12th April 2022.

- Further meetings with members of Cambourne Cricket Club, Tim Willett and the Community Development Officer to develop further the Camb Fest organised for September 2022. Work is progressing well with ticket sales going live early April 2022.
- Meeting with Cllr Bridget Smith, Cllr O'Dwyer and Cllr Poulton. Issues discussed included the link road through the business park, bringing forward the High Street and issues regarding planning including the reluctance of the Planning Department on involving town and Parish Councils in the s106 negotiations especially with the success the Council had achieved in the past with the 950 and West Cambourne s106's.
