### 12.1 Sports Pitches Bollard Email Correspondence

1. My daughter has just fallen down a massive hole caused by the vehicle access post being removed to access pitch 7. She is hurt. I have put the post back in. This was witnessed by the hot food stall lady. Please sort this out, I may be taking her to addenbroses!

2. Further to the email below, this is the post in question. It was not in the hole, I put it in to prevent further accidents. There were no vehicles on the pitches, so I guess it had been left out from someone accessing the pitch previously. Below is a photo of my daughters leg, she is limping but I imagine she will shake it off. It could easily have caused a broken leg - especially if running! Can I suggest you install a lay flat post instead to prevent reoccurrence?

3. From what I could see the post added no security at all as it can simply be removed and there is no way to secure it.

I don't believe the post removal had anything to do with the football managers as there were no vehicles on the fields.

In that area there were dozens of children running around. People are always going to forget to replace it and the next injury could be more serious!

As I initially suggested can you replace it with a lay flat post or similar. You will then be able to secure the area and if someone does forget to secure it at least there is no chance of injury.
