## Town Clerks Report

Below is a short update on activities since the 17<sup>th</sup> May 2022. Some elements are covered by separate agenda items.

- Continued discussions with Brandon Chandler, Management Trainee Taylor Wimpey and Mills and Reeve (the Councils solicitors) regarding their last areas in Upper Cambourne.
- West Cambourne meeting with Taylor to review existing consortium signage in Cambourne and discuss new ones for West Cambourne. The intention is to remove a number of the existing blue signs with the way marking signs (for facilities i.e. sports areas etc.) being kept and some new ones for West Cambourne being installed while West Cambourne is being built.
- Meetings with various parties and the Sport Development Officer (Football) regarding the development of football in Cambourne including the September football tournament.
- Further meetings with members of Cambourne Cricket Club and the Community Development Officer to develop further the CambFest.
- Taking part in a SAG Teams meeting with the Community Development Officer to review the arrangements for the Platinum Jubilee event for Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> June 2022. This was quite in depth, but was carried out in a supportive manner as they can only give advice.
- Meeting with Nicola Houghton, Business Improvement and Development Advisor, Cambridgeshire County Council to discuss community needs around the s106 monies allocated to health and the library. The need for an expanded medical facility was emphasised and the benefit of an enlarged library was explained. The need for dental and pharmacy provision was also raised.
- Various meetings with members of the boxing club regarding a venue. We were able to agree the use of The Hub meeting room 3 nights a week with discussions taking place over storage etc.
- Meeting at Cambourne Village College to review the Community Access Agreement with representatives from CVC, Cambridgeshire County Council and South Cambridgeshire District Council.
- Discussions with Louise Lord, South Cambridgeshire District Council around the agenda for the next A428 Development Cluster Forum – Cambourne and Bourn Airfield on 6<sup>th</sup> July 2022 this will be a zoom meeting. The next meeting on the 2<sup>nd</sup> November 2022 will be face to face.
