



# CAMBOURNE TOWN FC



## Proposal of use of the Cambourne Sports Pavilion.

### “THE OVERLOOK”

**WHEN:** Saturday and Sunday from the second weekend of September through until the last weekend of June. Morning sessions every weekend and afternoons when the adult teams are playing. In addition, Friday mornings, offering light refreshments for the walking football session which will be taking place 10-12.

**TIMES:** 8:30am start through until 8pm Plus possibly every month late night until 11pm on a Saturday for fundraising events.

**PROVIDING:** Hot and cold drinks, snacks e.g., crisps, chocolate bars, fruit. Bacon baps, Sausage baps, Chips etc. all day.

Alcoholic drinks to be served from 1pm on a Saturday and Sunday when adult games are being played.

**HOW WILL IT BE MANAGED:** To start with myself Emma Smith will be the main volunteer with the idea of asking for additional volunteers with a rota system being set up, once footfall increases.

**WHERE INCOME WILL GO:** After the initial outlay costs are covered, all profits made will go to Cambourne Town FC with the idea of the funds being used to help pay for upgrades to the football facilities i.e. Roll on goals, resurfacing of MUGA, new goals for MUGA.

**COMMUNITY BENEFITS:** Providing space for supporters of our teams to stay dry and get beverages etc. whilst watching their children play football. Additional space for refreshments whilst junior park run takes place on a Sunday. Supporting the community with early years provision and pan-ability sessions with onsite food and drink. Helping to sustain a venue for our walking football group to increase and provide exercise for our elder community residents. Plus provide an additional refreshment space for the whole community on a weekend. Raising money to help improve the sports facilities that we offer to our community.

**IN ADDITION:** Cleaning will be undertaken by ourselves of the sports pavilion on a weekend. Challenge 25 will be operated in regards to all alcohol sales.

Request to have a trophy cabinet for use of CTFC. Redecorating of the interior and Photo use of CTFC teams. Cleaning products and spare toilet rolls so regular checking whilst open can be made on the facilities.

Food hygiene certificates and a SCDC 5\* food quality will be obtained.
